



### Best Practice 1

**Title: Installment facility in fees for the economically weaker students.**

**Objective:**

- 1) To promote students for education in rural area.
- 2) To provide more fee installment facility for economically weaker student.
- 3) To increase the strength of students.

**Context:**

Shri Baneshwar Shikshan Sanstha's Arts, Commerce and Science College, Burhannagar is established for the students of rural areas. Students should not deprive from education belonging to rural area. Students are admitted with as much as fee possible. There is no coercion and hindrance to the students for taking the examination. This facility is available for economically weaker students.

**Practice:**

This college was established in 2003. Students are admitted in the college from rural and hilly area. Students from reserved and open category are admitted in the college. These students get scholarship from Maharashtra government so they don't face any problem for paying fees while taking admission. Those students who belong to open category has higher admission fees. Most of the students are from rural area and their parent's occupation is agriculture. Their sustenance is going on from the income earned from agriculture. Parents of students are not able to pay that fee immediately. Initially after the college started, it was noticed that some students were not taking admission due to lack of fees i.e., they were deprived of education.

The college has developed an admission process framework for the students. If the students do not have enough money while taking admission in the college then the students are admitted in the college by paying fee as much is possible. Then parents of the students pay the fees in instalments as they can. Due to this the dropout ratio decreased in the college.

Thus, this facility has been made available for the open category students of the college and the students have benefited from it.

**Evidence of Success:**

Initially B.A., B.Com. and B.Sc. courses was available in the college. But due to the installments in fees given by the college the number of students started to increase. Thus, the college was able to start B.Sc. (Computer science), B.B.A (C.A.) courses. It was possible for the students to continue their education without hurdle.

**Problems occurred:**

Since the college is non-grant, the college expenses are mostly dependent on student fees. Sometimes due to the instalments given in the fee college has to face financial crisis. Hence the college has to face a lot of problems.

**Title: Promoting research culture among staff and students.**

**Objectives:**

- 1.To motivate the staff members for PET, SET, NET examination of different universities.
- 2.To inspire the faculty members to pursue M.Phil. and Ph.D.
- 3.To motivate the staff members to publish their research papers.
- 4.To motivate the students to participate in Avishkar science project computation.

**The Context:**

Research is creative and systematic work undertaken to increase the knowledge. The research is very important in any higher educational institution because on the basis of research, students gain the additional knowledge. Research methodology is the specific technique or procedure used to identify select process and analyses information about topic. The college provides basic facilities for the research.

**The Practice:**

The college has competitive examination committee to motivate the staff and students. Staff members are motivated to apply for PET, SET, NET examination. The college provides required reference books, articles in the library. Faculty members are encouraged to participate in national and international conferences workshops, seminars for which the college provides TA/DA and duty leave. Science Association motivates student to participate in

Avishkar to develop research culture among students. Faculty members are also qualified SET, NET and PET examination.

**Evidence of the success:**

The college has successfully inculcated research culture. Three faculty members has been awarded Ph.D. last year. Number of faculty members has attempted PET examination. The faculty members have published 14 research papers in national and international journals, conferences, seminars and workshops. All departments organized programs and activities to motivate students about research and science.
